

Strategic Goals of the Y-12 Socioeconomic Program Office

The strategic goals of the Y-12 Socioeconomic Program Office are as follows:

- Effectively communicate with Y-12 National Security Complex personnel the objectives and goals of the Socioeconomic Program Office, ultimately educating and training the employees regarding the Socioeconomic Program commitment, expectations, practices and requirements.
- Communicate Y-12's objectives and goals of socioeconomic expectations, requirements and accomplishments to the public. Plan, participate and sponsor forums, conferences and formal associations.
- Maintain a world-class Mentor Protégé Program by assisting the growth and development of small businesses, Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs), and Minority Educational Institutions (MEIs).
- Provide program management expertise that exceeds normal expectations to ensure that the Socioeconomic Program Office is a premier organization for supporting socioeconomic needs, not only to Y-12 but to the National Nuclear Security Administration Complex as well. Obtain and manage the necessary resources to enhance and implement overall program goals.
- Increase and strengthen alliances with HBCUs and MEIs to enhance their ability to understand and take advantage of their capabilities, to seek work/research opportunities, to identify and obtain external projects, and to provide mentoring to strengthen the universities' fundamental support systems.
